SCHOOL VOUCHERS ARE APPROVED FOR 2012-13

After months of research and investigation, the School Board has voted to permit vouchers for the 2012-13 school year. Based on reports from area Lutheran schools who accepted vouchers for this school year, we believe vouchers will benefit our school. Should the School Board decide at a later date to reverse this decision, the school will simply not reapply for the next school year.

At this time vouchers are available to families who qualify for either free or reduced lunches and whose child has attended public school for the last two immediate semesters. First grade students, who received a scholarship in kindergarten through a recognized SGO (Scholarship Granting Organization), are exempt from the public school attendance requirement.
